Oral Pathology Made Easier

Professor & Chairman for the Department of Pathology and Medicine at the University of the Pacific School of Dentistry, San Francisco, California

Dr. Carpenter will present a clinical outline for oral mucosal lesions that makes it easy to understand what is occurring at a microscopic level with the use of illustrations. This outline will feature the distinction of lesions into white lesions red lesions and pigmentations. Dr. Carpenter will continue to illustrate lesions that may be clinically classified as vesiculobullous and ulcerative lesions and swellings. This program will emphasize the diagnosis of the more commonly presenting lesions but also delineate the more dangerous lesions and how to distinguish between the two. Treatment recommendations will also be elaborated along with details on which should be referred. At the conclusion of this course, the clinician should feel comfortable in assessing and treating or referring most of the commonly encountered mucosal lesions of the oral cavity.
